- 12" x 12" Textured Green Cardstock
- 12" x 12" Textured Burgundy Cardstock
- 12" x 12" Textured Yellow Cardstock
- 12" x 12" Circles and Dots Patterned Paper
- 'Las Vegas' Laser Cut Title
- Jo-Ann Craft Essentials 3-D Embellishment

Instructions

Tools:

- Xyron Model 900 Creative Station with a Permanent Adhesive cartridge
- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Hobby knife – optional

1. Trim the circles and dots patterned paper to 6" x 12".
2. Crop two photos, one to 4" x 4" and one to 3 1/2" x 4".
3. Cut mats for the photos. The yellow mats should be 1/4" larger than the photos on all sides and the burgundy mats should be 1/2" larger than the yellow mats on all sides.
4. Trim a 1/2" x 12" strip out of the burgundy cardstock.
5. Run all cut papers, photos and the 'Las Vegas' title through the Xyron Model 900 Creative Station making sure to make best use of the 9" wide cartridge.
6. After removing the film overlay, remove the patterned paper first and adhere to the bottom half of the green cardstock.
7. Apply the photos to the yellow mats and apply them to the burgundy mats and adhere to the page as shown.
8. Add the burgundy strip of paper approximately two inches down from the top of the green cardstock and place the title at an angle on top of that.
9. Finish the page using the Jo-Ann Craft Essentials Vacation tag.
